Internal Auditing Techniques for Aquaculture

Length of course: 1 day

Who is this course aimed at: This course is aimed at aquaculture staff who are required to deal with quality systems, internal audits or external auditors.

This one-day course provides an overview of the audit process and is intended to help aquaculture companies undertake effective internal audits and carry out any necessary corrective actions.

The course references GLOBALG.A.P. and British Retail Consortium (BRC) standards and covers both fish farm and fish processing facility auditing issues.

Entry Requirements: None. No prior knowledge of auditing.

Course Outcomes: Internal Auditing Techniques for Aquaculture certificate

Course Description: The course covers a range of topics relevant to the auditing of aquaculture operations, including:

- Why audits are carried out
- Different types of audit
- Audit planning
- How to audit and good auditing techniques.
- Responding effectively to non-conformance
- Root-cause analysis and how to employ it
- Practice conduct of an appropriate audit.
